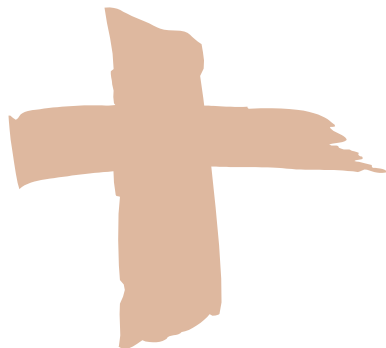


## Prayer Team
